Parking in Banff for Hotel Guests

 Hotel guests of the Banff Park Lodge (BPL) and the Peaks Hotel have access to daily selfparking for a charge not included in the guest room rate.

Parking in Banff for Non-Hotel Attendees

• For attendees not staying with the BPL or the Peaks Hotel, there is minimal free parking along the river behind the BPL on Bow Avenue, and you may also check at the BPL Front Desk to inquire if there is any parking available on site. If available, the rate will be \$14/day plus tax. Alternatively, attendees are asked to visit the Town of Banff website Parking | Banff, AB for information regarding parking options.
